Our future is set by our past. The most important legacy of the Kankakee Area YMCA is for the common good to be safeguarded by common citizens like you


and me. It's what YMCA leaders before us knew and taught. We must pass down this message from one generation to the next.

# Remembering Walter John “Jack” Charlton (1919 - 2006)

On Sunday, December 31, 2006, the Kankakee Area YMCA said goodbye to a legend, Walter John “Jack” Charlton. In the history of the Kankakee Area YMCA, there was no greater volunteer and friend to the YMCA. Jack dedicated over fifty years of his life to the YMCA as a Trustee, fundraiser, Lamplighter, advocate, and member.

Jack Charlton was born Aug. 9, 1919, in Watertown, S.D., the son of Walter Leslie and Grace Wells Charlton. He grew up in the Minneapolis area and served in the U.S. Army in World War II, earning a Bronze Star.

He moved to Kankakee in 1946 at the invitation of the late Lou Beckman, whom he had met during the war and began a long association with First Trust & Savings Bank in 1950, becoming its president in 1965. He also served as president of the First Bank of Meadowview. In 1998, Jack was instrumental in organizing the First Trust Bank of Illinois and was one of its founding directors.

In 1948, he married the love of his life, Gretchen Beckman. All who knew Jack know how he cherished Gretchen and their time together, and how much he missed her after she passed away in 2004. Jack was also a loving father to his daughter Julie. In his later years, Jack spent considerable time dedicated to his two grandsons, Ted and Andy.


Jack first became involved with the Kankakee Area YMCA in the 1950's. He was committed to a healthy lifestyle and would come to the YMCA on a regular basis until he was well into his 80's. In 1966, Jack was one of the founding fathers of the YMCA Board of Trustees. He was also one of its youngest members and would serve as a trustee until his death in 2006.

Soon after taking on this new assignment as a trustee, the YMCA launched a building fund drive to construct “a new home” for the Kankakee Area YMCA. Jack would take a leadership role in this campaign. Walter Hill, YMCA Executive Director 1963-1970 stated, “Jack was the key person that brought businesses, community leaders, and financial institutions to support the building of the YMCA. He was the powerhouse that made the YMCA possible. He had the Kankakee community at heart.”

Jack's charity was legendary. Some people give their money. Some people give their time. Some people give their leadership. Jack gave all three. His expectation was for others to match this philosophy and he was never afraid to challenge people to step up to the plate.

After leading the successful campaign to build the YMCA, Jack would go on to be one of the key leaders in raising funds for all major projects at the YMCA. Those projects would include the building of the Swan Pool, a second gym, racquetball courts, locker rooms, tennis courts and the facility renovations in 2001. He was also a key leader for the Strong Kids Campaign by heading up the Chairman's Roundtable division. Without Jack Charlton's leadership, these projects and campaigns would not have successfully occurred.

Jack was a banker, developer and a noted philanthropist. There was a less publicized side to Jack. Wes Walker, YMCA Executive Director 1970-1995



stated, “If there was a project at the YMCA that required physical labor, Jack was not afraid to roll-up his sleeves and get dirty.”

Jack Charlton once said “I do what I do from the heart.” On behalf of the thousands of kids and families that have been served, over the years, by the YMCA, we thank Jack Charlton for sharing his heart with the YMCA. Jack was a true leader of the community whose vision and great example did make a difference.

Jack Charlton was given 87 years of life. He filled those years with purpose, a gracious spirit, and faithful service to God, community, and country to the very end. Jack Charlton leaves behind the gratitude of the YMCA and our community. We're proud of Jack Charlton, and the YMCA honors his memory. May God bless him and may he remain an example of service for future generations.
